Gene and Genie 2020-22 water-based paints, ink, dyes and beeswax on t-shirts (from me, my Dad, my boyfriend, and several strangers); backed with dyed linen, cut and sewn 75 3/4 inches high x 56 1/2" wide



2020-22 water-based paints and ink on denim, dyed denim, and dyed twill jeans and trousers (sourced from me, my boyfriend Andy, my Dad, my Mom, and from Basel, Rafael, and Freja), cut and sewn, and backed with embroidered linen pieces 63 1/8 high x 47 1/2 wide



2022
Ink and water based paints and dyes on cotton, linen, silk, and ramie dress shirt fabric and cotton t-shirt fabric (sourced from my Dad, from my boyfriend Andy, from my ex-boyfriend, from Brooks, from an anonymous painter, from an anonymous lawyer, and from a stranger), backed with dyed and embroidered linen

Walnut wood, cast rubber, and hand-pigmented urethane in dripping sequence created for Chelsea Music Festival
42.5 inches high x 33.5 inches wide x 4.25 inches deep



water-based media on cotton shirts and chambray (sourced from me, from my boyfriend Andy, and from Nayef), backed in dyed and embroidered linen, with overdyed denim and twill fabrics (sourced from family and friends), cut and sewn 53 inches high x 39 inches wide

Powder-coated steel shelving, unique photocopies, amaryllis bulbs, and studio scraps in various arrangements, placed and adapted by the artist throughout the course of the Festival.
